

JOINING IMC YOUTH

If you would like to work with people under 30 across the world, assisting in collaborative activities and advocacy that meet the goals and priorities of IMC Youth, then you should consider joining IMC Youth. Joining IMC Youth provides opportunities of participating in working groups, networking, and forums through the International Music Council. There are two types of ways to join IMC Youth:

1) Any IMC member organisation (or member of an IMC member)

Please designate a representative who should be under 30.

2) Any individual under the age of 30 supported by an IMC Member organisation.

THE FIVE MUSICAL RIGHTS

All IMC members' representatives and individuals who join IMC Youth must subscribe to the IMC's five musical rights:

The right for or all children and adults

- to express themselves musically in all freedom
- to learn musical languages and skills
- to have access to musical involvement through participation, listening, creation, and information

The right for all musical artists

- to develop their artistry and communicate through all media, with proper facilities at their disposal
- to obtain just recognition and remuneration for their work.

IMC YOUTH COMMITTEE

IMC Youth is governed by the IMC Youth Committee. Committee members are required to:

- meet throughout the year both on-line and in person
- work to meet the goals and priorities of IMC Youth
- assist others in IMC Youth to contribute to the goals and priorities of IMC Youth.

Elections are held every year, rotating on 2-year terms, at the IMC World Forum on Music or online. There are 7 voted members of the Committee and up to 3 co-opted positions.
